Helpful Information for the Baptism of your Child

Congratulations! We are very pleased that you have scheduled a Sacrament to be performed at the Greek Orthodox Community of Saint Catherine's in Braintree, MA. We would like to offer the following information for your careful consideration.

- 1. Parents are expected to be stewards in good standing of Saint Catherine's Greek Orthodox Church. A stewardship form is available upon request. In addition, the following documentation is needed:
 - Birth Certificate of Child
 - Wedding Certificate of Parents (if not married in our church)
- 2. The Sponsor (Godparent) must be an Orthodox Christian in good standing with the Church and with his/her parish. The Sponsor should have a letter from his/her parish if he/she is not a member of Saint Catherine's. The Orthodox Church allows for one Godparent or possibly a couple who have been married in the Church and are in good standing.
 - If the sponsor is not a member of an Orthodox parish, they will be required to become steward of St. Catherine's. A stewardship form is available upon request
 - Further documentation needed:
 - Baptismal Certificate (if single)
 - Marriage Certificate (if married)
- 3. If the parents and the sponsor are stewards of another parish, a facilities fee of \$500 will be required.
- 4. It is customary to give a voluntary offering to the sexton and chanter for their services. You can turn these monetary gifts in sealed envelopes with the rest of the paperwork.
- 5. The items listed below are to be brought to the church on the day of the Baptism either by the parent or the sponsor:
 - Small vessel with olive oil
 - Bar of soap
 - Three candles
 - A hand towel and bath towel
 - A large white sheet
 - A new white Christening outfit for the child
 - A cross for the child
- 6. Kindly submit all required documents and fees to the church at least two (2) weeks before the baptism, so that the Baptismal Certificate may be prepared in a timely fashion. Should you have any questions, please feel free to call the priest or the church secretary at 781-843-0047. Thank You!
